ACADEMIC SESSION 2026–27 | ICSE EXAMINATION YEAR 2027

Note: The Term I and Term II division below is a school-level teaching/examination division of the official CISCE ICSE Year 2027 syllabus. CISCE publishes the annual syllabus rather than a separate Term I/Term II board syllabus.

1. ENGLISH

TERM I

- Language: Composition; letter writing; notice/email where prescribed; comprehension; grammar; vocabulary; transformation of sentences; functional writing and other prescribed language skills.
- Literature: First-half prescribed portions of the drama, prose and poetry texts; themes, characters, literary devices, context-based questions and critical appreciation.

TERM II

- Language: Remaining prescribed writing, comprehension, grammar and transformation skills; full-syllabus practice.
- Literature: Remaining prescribed portions of drama, prose and poetry; themes, characters, literary devices, context-based questions and complete revision.

2. SECOND LANGUAGE (HINDI / BENGALI / OTHER APPROVED LANGUAGE)

TERM I

- Prescribed prose and poetry – first-term portions; grammar; composition; letter/application writing; comprehension; vocabulary and language exercises.

TERM II

- Remaining prescribed prose and poetry; grammar and writing skills; comprehension; complete literature and language revision.

3. HISTORY & CIVICS

TERM I

- Civics: The Union Legislature; The Union Executive; The Judiciary.
- History: The First World War and its causes; Rise of Dictatorships; Second World War; first prescribed portion of the Indian National Movement.

TERM II

- Indian National Movement – remaining prescribed topics; Mass Phase; Independence and Partition; Contemporary World / United Nations and related prescribed topics; complete revision.

4. GEOGRAPHY

TERM I

- Map Work and Topographical Map Work; first prescribed units on physical geography/resources; climate; soil and natural vegetation; water resources.

TERM II

- Mineral and Energy Resources; Agriculture; Industries; Transport; Waste Management; remaining prescribed map work/topographical skills; full revision.

5. MATHEMATICS

TERM I

- Commercial Mathematics: Banking, shares/dividends and taxation (as prescribed).
- Algebra: Linear Inequations, Quadratic Equations, Ratio and Proportion, Factorisation, Matrices and Arithmetic/Geometric Progression (prescribed portions).
- Geometry: Similarity, Loci and Circles (first-term portions).

TERM II

- Coordinate Geometry; Trigonometry; Mensuration; Statistics; Probability; remaining Algebra and Geometry; full-syllabus problem solving and revision.

6. PHYSICS

TERM I

- Force, Work, Power and Energy; Machines; Light – reflection/refraction and lenses; Sound (prescribed first-term portions).

TERM II

- Electricity and Magnetism; Heat; Modern Physics; remaining prescribed topics; numerical practice, diagrams and complete revision.

7. CHEMISTRY

TERM I

- Periodic Properties and variation of properties; Chemical Bonding; Acids, Bases and Salts; Analytical Chemistry; Mole Concept and Stoichiometry; first prescribed portions of Electrolysis/Metallurgy.

TERM II

- Metallurgy; Study of Compounds – Hydrogen Chloride, Ammonia, Nitric Acid, Sulphuric Acid and prescribed compounds; Organic Chemistry; practical/observational work and complete revision.

8. BIOLOGY

TERM I

- Basic Biology and Cell-related concepts; Plant Physiology; Human Anatomy and Physiology – first prescribed units; diagrams and laboratory-related concepts.

TERM II

- Human Population / Health-related prescribed units; Genetics and Evolution; Environmental Biology; remaining prescribed topics; diagrams and complete revision.

9. COMPUTER APPLICATIONS

TERM I

- Revision of Java fundamentals; classes and objects; data types; operators; input/output; conditional statements; loops; methods; constructors; basic programming exercises.

TERM II

- Arrays; Strings; library classes; recursion/advanced programming concepts as prescribed; searching/sorting; output tracing; programming practice and complete revision.

INTERNAL ASSESSMENT / PROJECT / PRACTICAL WORK: To be completed according to the subject-wise CISCE requirements and the school's academic schedule.

TERM I EXAMINATION: First-term portion as listed above.

TERM II / ANNUAL EXAMINATION: Remaining portion plus systematic revision and ICSE board-oriented practice.
